### STARK JFS PROGRAM HELPS PARENTS WITH NEW CHILD SUPPORT ORDERS

**Canton, Ohio** - Stark County Job and Family Services' Division of Child Support is seeking applicants for the Right Path for Fathers Partnership, a program providing valuable resources and support to parents with new child support orders. This is a free program and is a limited-time opportunity for those who have received child support orders within the last six months.

Right Path is designed to assist parents in employment, connecting with their families, and supporting their children. Those who are selected to participate in Right Path services will receive individualized employment supports and certificate programs provided by Goodwill Stark Campus and Stark State, parenting support from other parents and professionals, and individual access to help with navigating child support.

Additionally, parents can benefit from guidance with securing and maintaining a steady income, staying on top of their child support orders, obtaining a parenting time order, and establishing new strategies for effective parenting.

Right Path is part of a research study, sponsored by the United States Department of Health and Human Services in partnership with the Social Security Administration. There are a limited number of spots available. Eligible individuals will be selected at random for these limited slots.
