

Public Hearing Announcement

Stark County Job and Family Services (SCJFS) announces a public hearing for Thursday, May 27, 2021, to seek input on the future expenditures of Title XX funds.

Title XX monies are a mixture of federal and state funds which are used for child protective services, and purchased social services, primarily funded by the federal government, such as adult day care, homemaker services, transportation and protective services for adults.

Oral and written testimony will be accepted at the public hearing which is being co-sponsored by SCJFS planning committee, Stark County Board of Developmental Disabilities, and Stark County Mental Health & Addiction Recovery. The hearing will be held from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 27, 2021, by teleconference. To attend the hearing, please dial 1-614-230-0229, Meeting ID 835423#. However, written testimony will be accepted by SCJFS through May 24, 2021.

The public is encouraged to provide input about Title XX, which primarily serves the needs in the community for the two-year funding period beginning October 1, 2021. Title XX primarily serves the needs of low to middle income families.
