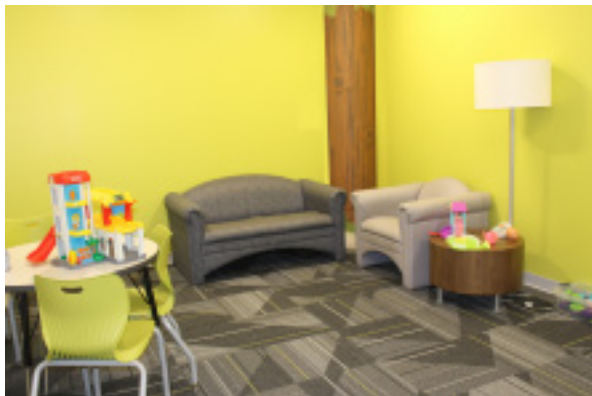

Visitation Center

The Children Services Division of Stark County Job and Family Services (SCJFS) is pleased to offer families a state-of-the-art family visitation center for supervised visitation. The Center is located in the Cornerstone building, 402 2nd Street SE in Canton, Ohio and includes:

- six individual visitation rooms decorated with a comfortable, home-like setting complete with children's games, toys and activity centers
- a central eating area with a microwave, refrigerator and sink for food preparation and clean-up is available
- a fully equipped bathroom for Visitation Center guests which contains a changing station
- lots of child-friendly art and bright colors throughout



Use of Visitation Center

The Center is designed for supervised visits between parents/guardians and their children. With prior approval, additional visitors may attend. Special events and celebrations, such as birthdays, must be pre-approved by the case worker.



Visitation Hours

The Visitation Center is open Mondays through Fridays from 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. The Center is closed on weekends and holidays on which SCJFS is closed.

Parents/visitors are responsible for their own transportation unless other arrangements are made. If parents/visitors are more than 15 minutes late, the visit will be canceled.

On-street, metered parking is available on both Second and Third Streets. There is also limited parking in the agency lot. Please allow time to locate parking so that you do not take away from your visitation time.

Visitation Center Information

Upon arrival visitors are asked to sign in at the reception desk in the front lobby.

Parents/visitors are encouraged to bring food, beverages and family-friendly activities for their visit. All food and beverages are to be consumed in the dining area, not in individual visitation rooms.

If food and beverages are served, it is the family's responsibility to wipe off tables and chairs and clean up spills and food on the floor.

Ten minutes prior to the end of a visit, parents/visitors are asked to assist their children with putting toys and games away and making sure that the visitation room is returned to its original condition.

A visit will be terminated if there are disruptions, threats, fights, or indication that a parent/visitor is under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

The use of personal cell phones is prohibited during visits except for an emergency or when approved by staff.

Pets may not be brought to visits.
